### II. Secretary's Report- Kim Barnes

## III. Treasurer's Report- Bre Thompson

# V. Committee Reports- Committee Chairs

- a. **Concessions** Sarah has increased prices of drinks to be in line with the high school and other area school concessions. Pepsi and water will now be \$2.00. Popcorn bags will now be \$2.00. Sarah is also wanting to use clear bins for candy and other food on the cart. This will allow for easy label pricing and organization. *Jodi S made a motion to increasing pricing for outdoor and indoor concessions.*Jamie C 2<sup>nd</sup>, all present were in favor and the motion passed.
- b. **Yard Signs** Kim reported Pip Printing will be creating and handling yard signs going forward. Pip charges a one-time fee of \$250. Parents will order and pay for the signs on the Pip website and pick up the signs from Pip located at 8325 N Allen Rd in Peoria. The signs available are baseball, softball, cross country, girls' basketball, boys' basketball, cheerleading, dance, volleyball, track, band, chorus, orchestra, scholastic bowl, 8<sup>th</sup> grade graduation.
- c. Fannie May- Tara reported Fannie May kick off will happen on Monday, September 22. Order forms will be due on Tuesday, October 7. No money will be collected at this time, only order forms. There will be several students not participating due to difficulties from last year and several students will need permission to sell. Tara will be sending out a Sign Up for the collection day. Volunteers will be needed at the front of each house.
- d. **Teacher Appreciation** Staff lunch will be served on Friday September 19. \$190 was donated to help by for Olive Garden. Parents are also donating drinks and desserts.
- e. Fall Fest- Kim reported Fall Fest will take place on Saturday October 18 from 5:00-7:00 in the parking lot of DVMS by the soccer field. There will be a Truck or Treat, costume parade and competition, food trucks (still finalizing), scary trail.
